Exclusion or Exception? Medicare pays for some health care services but not for others.

While Medicare has traditionally denied payment for a range of services and items under broad categories, some exclusions are not as hard and fast as they may at first appear to be. Medicare pays for certain procedures when patients meet certain conditions of coverage.

SMP Rural Community of Practice: Knocking Down Old Barriers

The pilot CoP tests the use of peer-to-peer sharing, learning, collaboration, and organizational development. It identifies potential new partners and re-envisions different ways for overcoming barriers. Notable resources include census data, rural health clinics, library videoconferencing, targeted social media, a VA rural health toolkit, cooperative extensions, and Extension Homemakers.

What to Know About the Updated Telemarketing Sales Rule

Changes in the FTC's Telemarketing Sales Rule make it against the law for callers to ask people to pay with a cash-to-cash money transfer, among other things. People should be skeptical about any telemarketer who pressures them to pay a certain way.
