Federal Report Roundup: Health Care Anti-fraud Efforts Recover \$2.4 Billion

SMP saves more than \$122 million. ACL works to quantify the effect of preventative education. On average in FY 2013-2015, \$6.10 was recovered for every dollar spent from the HCFAC program. The FY 2015 Medicare FFS program improper payment rate was 12.1 percent, representing \$43.3 billion in improper payments. Medicare tops the list of all federal program improper payments.

Self-Administered Drug Denials Confuse Beneficiaries

Beneficiaries often assume that Medicare covers medications they receive during an emergency room visit, outpatient procedure, or observation stay under Part B. They don't know that, with some exceptions, Part B does not pay for drugs that patients usually self-administer. Here are four things SMPs can do to help beneficiaries.


Partnership Yields Benefits for SMP and SHIIP
