Will We Finally Eliminate the SSN as the Medicare Number?

Identity theft ranks at the top of the FTC's list of complaints, with the number of individuals impacted rising. When an SSN is involved in a data breach, a person is five times more likely to become a victim of fraud. New estimates from CMS have more than halved the cost to remove SSNs from Medicare numbers. Congress is taking up the issue for the third time.
