Introduction

Purpose

The Senior Medicare Patrol National Resource Center (SMP Resource Center) engaged Health Benefits ABCs (HBABCs) to help develop a national profile of the 54 Senior Medicare Patrol (SMP) program models and partnerships. There is an SMP program in every state, the District of Columbia, Guam, Puerto Rico, and the Virgin Islands. The data in this publication helps the SMP Resource Center and the Administration for Community Living (ACL) respond to questions from SMPs and others about the way SMP programs are configured, individually and collectively. This profile begins with national summary data to selected survey questions and concludes with a two-page individual profile of each SMP.

Process

In May 2014, SMP project directors were asked to update their 2013 profiles. This publication is the result of that effort. All SMPs provided a response to the initial inquiry and were invited in July to review their updated profile information to make corrections, if needed.

Two fields of information were updated automatically: 1) The number of years each agency has held the SMP grant was automatically increased by one year, and 2) The number of active volunteers for each SMP was updated based upon the July 2014 Office of Inspector General (OIG) report of 2013 SMP performance data (https://oig.hhs.gov/oei/reports/oei-02-13-00170.pdf).

Because of the rate of SMP project director turnover, this document may not always reflect the most current contact information available. If needed, use the SMP search tool at www.smpresource.org, which contains the most current SMP contact information available.

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



Summary Data: SHIP cross-tabulations

In the following remaining summary tables and listings, data is cross-tabulated to explore the effects of SMP service model dependence upon SHIP, SMP/SHIP colocation, and SMP/SHIP comanagement. Service model dependence means the SMP program in that state or territory is dependent upon the SHIP (regardless of whether or not the programs are colocated or comanaged). Colocation means the agency receiving the SMP grant also receives the SHIP grant for its state. Comanagement means the programs are managed together (regardless of whether or not the same agency receives both grants).

The following comparison is not meant to imply that colocation or comanagement are more or less effective than any other SMP/SHIP partnership model. It is meant, instead, to illustrate that there is not a simple answer to the question, "How many SMPs are also SHIPs?" Colocation and comanagement may or may not result in program integration (or service model dependence), as these profile results show.
